The Consent Coalition is responsible for creating safe, supportive and effective sexual violence and consent resources and messaging. Therefore the Consent Coalition has the intellectual property rights, including ownership and copyright on all its resources, campaigns and designs. Organisations are welcome to use and share our resources and information, provided that they are unchanged and the Consent Coalition is referenced. The Consent Coalition only endorses messages that are created by themselves. This provides reassurance that the resources and messages have been designed by professionals in the sexual violence and abuse field, ensuring the targeted messages are safe and relevant.
