We're hosting a woman-only in-person event with The Health Shop. Held at Nottingham Women's Centre, you will be able to find out about the free sexual health and contraceptive services available for those facing severe and multiple disadvantage or who feel unable to access mainstream healthcare.



Free Naloxone Training will also be given at this event. With the rise of accidental overdoses, this is useful, safe and life-saving training for all front-line staff.




Celebrate the Derbyshire Your Journey Launch!


